MAKE THE MOST OF REFRESHER TRAINING

To ensure that you make the most of the refresher course, here are some tips from VOSA's Technical Trainers:

- Read your call-up letter carefully and check the enclosed map. Make sure you know exactly where the course is being held and allow plenty of time to arrive for 08.45 check in. Make allowances for roadworks and regular traffic jams. By all means phone ahead if you are lost or late. If you arrive more than 30 minutes late, you will be turned away.
- Bring paper, pen, and if needed, your glasses. This is a common problem trainers come across. You'll need your glasses whether you are long or short sighted for close-up work on the manual and distance work on the board and flip chart.
- Bring lunch or money to buy a snack during the break.
- Don't bring your own MOT manual and guide. Your colleagues back at your garage will need them while they conduct tests. There are copies at the training centre to use on the course.
- Make sure you are familiar with the manual and its layout. This shouldn't be a problem, as a good tester will consult it regularly.
- If you don't test regularly, try to do a few before the course so you are entirely familiar with the process and the paperwork.
- Make sure you are familiar with all the equipment in you own garage, especially exhaust gas analysers. If you have any problems or queries, you can raise them on the course.
- Prepare for the course by listing any problems you've encountered when testing in your own garage. These will provide a useful starting point for the course, and you can guarantee that if you are having a problem with an issue, then so will other people in your group. The course is a good opportunity to discuss and share ideas.
- Come with an open mind. Be prepared for a new style of course. Be willing to challenge your own ideas about testing and don't be afraid to discuss any problems with the trainer.

Remember, it's your course. Make the most of it.
